Eligibility & Terms

To ensure a smooth transition and experienced leadership, the following requirements apply:

- **Board Director:** Must be a member in good standing for at least 3 months prior to the election. (1-year term)
- **Officer:** Must have served 2 consecutive years as a Director immediately preceding the election. (2-year term)

Note: All roles require attending monthly board meetings and accountability to the Board.

Open Positions

We are looking for enthusiastic individuals for the following roles:

- **Bingo:** Recruits monthly volunteers and serves as the onsite Chairperson for bingo events.
- **Building & Grounds:** A handy resident to oversee minor maintenance and manage subcontractors.
- **Casino:** Coordinates volunteers and serves as Chairperson for our casino dates.
- **Communications:** Help us spread the word, from promoting events online to crafting newsletters that keep the community informed. We have split this into three focused roles: **Newsletter, Facebook, and Website.**

- **Sports:** Coordinates with local organizations to get our community's youth active and onto teams.

Treaty 8 First Nations of Alberta Celebrates Grand Opening of Station Pointe Development

This Indigenous-owned housing initiative marks a significant milestone in urban Indigenous housing leadership.

Originally initiated in 2016 following the launch of Canada's National Housing Strategy, early efforts faced funding challenges and delays. However, Treaty 8 remained steadfast in their commitment to creating culturally appropriate housing solutions in Edmonton. In 2018 Treaty 8 Urban Child and Family Services joined the project, partnering to develop the initiative at Station Pointe. Through perseverance and collaboration, funding was secured in 2023 and under the Post Majority Support Services Program administered by Indigenous Services Canada and contributions by ABIF and City of Edmonton. Constructed using precast concrete and completed within one year. Station Pointe Development officially opened its doors on November 1, 2024, but celebrated its grand opening March 10, 2026

The development consists of two buildings and includes 62 fully furnished residential suites for Indigenous youth aging out of foster care requiring assistance to succeed out on their own. This development also includes an Elders room and childcare space / Community kitchen and training spaces / Offices and programs space / Gym, First Aid and medical room / Outdoor rink and secure playground / Maintenance and security offices / 24/7 On-site security staff. This one-of-a-kind facility provides safe, culturally appropriate housing owned and managed by Treaty 8 First Nations of Alberta.

The Station Pointe Development increases Edmonton's affordable housing supply while contributing positivity to the surrounding neighbourhood.

What is A Community League?

A community League is a *volunteer*, not-for profit organization formed to meet the unique needs and interests of the residents within a defined geographic area.

The role of Community League is to:

- Speak on behalf of their Community League members and
- Report on behalf of all residents within the leagues specified geographical area
- Bring neighbors together
- Provide recreation and social programs
- Develop amenities
- Represent community interests to government and other organizations

A Community League is an autonomous body, registered under the Societies Act with the Corporate Registry of the Government of Alberta. Therefore, it must have a properly elected board of directors, responsible for carrying out the business of the league.
